SUGGESTED SIGHTSEEING PLAN

ISTANBUL

May 2, 2027, Sunday - Istanbul

Meet your guide in the lobby of your hotel at 09:00.

Constantine the Great decided to leave the weary and tired Rome behind to find a new Rome, where west met east, a city that would be the powerhouse of the world for centuries to come: Constantinople.

The day starts with a visit to Hagia Sophia, the jewel of the city, a.k.a. the Divine Wisdom, the largest dome of Christendom for about a thousand years. Then, you will continue to the ancient Hippodrome, where sports were the excuse, but politics was the real game, you listen to stories of emperors and empresses who struggled for power. You will marvel at the jaw-dropping architecture in the Underground Cistern, one of the largest water supplies at the heart of the capital city.

In the afternoon, you will head to the Byzantine land walls and visit the Church of St. Savior in Chora and see the glittering golden mosaics adorning the interior.

May 3, 2027, Monday - Istanbul

A catalyst for a major transformation, undeniably the Ottomans shaped the Old World's trajectory into the modern age through extensive political, economic, military and cultural interactions. Istanbul was the crown jewel of their empire.

The Topkapı Palace was both the seat of the government and home of the Sultans for 400 years. In this exclusive tour of the Topkapı Palace, you will visit the numerous courtyards, including the Harem, Treasury, and Sacred Relics.

Your day continues with visits to two of Istanbul's majestic mosques, the Blue Mosque and the Mosque of Suleyman the Magnificent.

ANKARA & HATTUŞAŞ

Take your domestic flight from Istanbul to Ankara in the morning. Upon arrival, meet your driver and guide at Ankara Airport. Then you will head for Ankara, capital city of modern Turkey.

After a brief orientation in Ankara, drive to the ancient citadel for the Museum of Anatolian Civilizations - a great introduction to Anatolian cultures, from prehistoric times to the Roman Empire.

May 6, 2027, Thursday - Hattuşaş, Yazılıkaya & Cappadocia

Meet your guide and driver in the lobby of your hotel at 08:00.

Drive toward Cappadocia with visits to Hattuşaş and Yazılıkaya en route.

Hattuşaş was the heart of the Hittite Empire, a Bronze Age superpower that signed the world's first peace treaty — a replica of which stands today at the United Nations in New York. As you pass through lion- and sphinx-guarded gates, explore monumental city walls, and step into vast temple complexes, you will sense the scale and confidence of a civilization that left a lasting imprint on world history.

Only a short distance away lies Yazılıkaya, the open-air sanctuary where Hittite kings honored their gods. Here, rows of deities carved more than 3,000 years ago line the rock walls, their images remarkably vivid in the daylight.

Continue to Cappadocia and check in to your cave boutique hotel.

CAPPADOCIA

May 7, 2027, Friday - Cappadocia

Breakfast at the hotel. Meet your Cappadocian guide in the lobby at 09:00.

Meet your guide at the airport and drive to the heart of the region. En route, you may stop at Derwent, Paşabağ or the Pigeons Valley to observe and photograph some of the most picturesque land and rock formations.

In the afternoon, you will visit the Göreme Open Air Museum and the late Byzantine churches carved in the rock. The museum is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Based on the time and your personal interest, you may visit a pottery workshop, to learn more about this traditional craft, and the ancient kick-wheel.

May 8, 2027, Saturday - Cappadocia

Hot-air balloon ride at sunrise. Round-trip shuttle is included, and the pick-up time will be shared the day before.

In the morning, stroll the tiny streets of Mustafapaşa, a typical Cappadocian village under state preservation for authenticity of its architecture. The walk will give you a clear look and understanding of the geography, culture, and history of Cappadocia.

After lunch, you will visit the Uçhisar Castle. You will then drive to the underground city of Kaymakli that was once a temporary shelter in times of danger and siege. Later in the day, you may visit a local winery, a carpet weaving facility, or both.

May 9, 2027, Sunday - Cappadocia

Breakfast at the hotel.

In the morning, you will enjoy a nature walk in either Gomedra or the Ihlara Valley, to appreciate the Cappadocian landscape. Then you will drive off the beaten path to the town of Guzelyurt for lunch, home of St. Gregory of Nazianus.

In the afternoon, you will walk through ancient Guzelyurt, to see the centuries old cave dwellings, and the renowned Church of St. Gregory. The original church was physically built by St. Gregory of Nazianus, one of the founding fathers of the Orthodox faith.

In the evening, attend a Whirling Dervish performance in a historical caravanserai.

KONYA & ANTALYA

May 10, 2027, Monday - Konya

Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Drive to Konya.

Meet your SRM guide at the main entrance of the Museum of Whirling Dervishes in the afternoon. Sleep in Konya for 1 night.

May 11, 2027, Tuesday - Antalya

Continue to Antalya and check in to your hotel in the Old Town.

The Turkish Mediterranean coastline is characterized by its namesake climate, lush vegetation, fertile soil and abundance of rivers carrying fresh water from the majestic Taurus Mountain range.

Antalya is an ideal place to enjoy a "vacation from your vacation." You will visit the impressive ancient Greek sculptures in the Antalya Museum, one of Turkey's finest archaeological museums; explore the narrow and cobbled streets of Antalya's old town and Roman harbor.

LAODICEA, PAMUKKALE

May 15, 2027, Saturday - Pamukkale

Travel to Pamukkale and check in to your thermal hotel.

May 16, 2027, Sunday - Laodicea, Hierapolis & Pamukkale

Meet your guide in the lobby of your hotel at 10:00.

Drive to the ancient Laodicea. It was one of the Seven Churches of Revelation. Today, it is impressive, restored public buildings mirror the glory of the Roman era.

Pamukkale and Hierapolis are listed by UNESCO as a mixed World Heritage Site recognized for both exceptional natural features and cultural significance. It is a rare union of nature and civilization.

Pamukkale, which means "Cotton Castle" in Turkish, is dazzling due to the brilliant white travertine terraces cascading gently down the hillside, which led to the establishment of the ancient city of Hierapolis next to it with its mineral rich waters thought to have healing properties.

During a visit to this ancient city, you will stroll the necropolis among various tomb styles -sarcophagi, tumuli and house-shaped tombs- visit the martyrrium of Apostle St. Philip, take a quick dip in a natural spring pool amid the remains of Roman columns, see the oracle center of Apollo, and visit the beautifully curated Archaeological Museum.

EPHESUS

May 17, 2027, Monday - Ephesus

Meet your guide and driver in the lobby of your hotel at 09:00.

Your exclusive tour includes the Odeon, State Agora, Domitian Square and Temple, Fountain of Pollio, Nike Monument, Curets Street, Roman Baths, the Terrace Houses, Library of Celsus, the Marble Street, Commercial Agora, the Great Theatre and more. After a relaxing local lunch, you will visit the House of the Virgin Mary, where it's believed she spent the last years of her life; the Ephesus Museum, displaying some of the best artifacts from the site, plus the Basilica of St. John, where the apostle is said to be entombed.
